



The Dad Game

What you need: a 15 second timer

How to play: Have Dad start the timer and read the first assignment aloud. (i.e. *Start singing my favorite song.*) All players race to be the first one to complete the task within 15 seconds. Whoever successfully completes it first wins a point. Note: Dad is the judge *and* answer key. Even though players are singing “Row, Row, Row Your Boat,” “Humpty Dumpty,” and “Mary Had a Little Lamb,” Dad waits to award any player the point until he hears what he considers his favorite song, “Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star.” If no players sings “Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star” after the 15 seconds are up, Dad wins a point. Whoever has the most points at the end of the game wins.

Assignments:

1. Start singing my favorite song.
2. Tell me what my favorite dessert is.
3. Say my favorite expression.
4. Tell me my first pet’s name.
5. Call me by my childhood nickname.
6. Tell me the name of my favorite book.
7. Act out the first musical instrument I played.
8. Tell me the name of my favorite TV show or Movie.
9. Act out my go-to dance move.
10. Tell me the name of my best friend growing up.
11. Act out my favorite sport to play (or watch).
12. Tell my favorite dad joke.
